

## Historic Bhadawar Yatra sets a new record

For the first time in the history of Shri Mathur Chaturvedi Samaj, this innovation was started in which the brothers and mother power living in different states of India participated enthusiastically with great affection, enthusiasm and excitement.

The grand inauguration of the Bhadawar Yatra was done on the morning of 28th October on the banks of Yamuna Maiya by the Vedic chanting done by the revered Peethadhishwar of Shri Ji Peeth Shri Kant Baba and Shri Pankaj Ji Shastri in unison in which a large number of indigenous relatives present on the banks of Yamuna Ji. After duly worshipping Yamuna ji and Baba Bateshwar Nath, the Yatra left for Pinahat with deafening cheers.

All the pilgrims who reached the Ramleela site in Pinahat were welcomed and arranged for refreshments by the indigenous relatives of Pinahat.

After spending some time in Pinahat, the yatra group left for Talgaon with their respective vehicles and on reaching Talgaon, all the yatris were greeted by the chief coordinator of the yatra and the honorable patron of Shri Mathur Chaturvedi Maha Parishad - Shri Hiralal ji Pandey, Shri Ashok ji Pandey. by local relatives Heartfelt welcome was given and everyone thoroughly enjoyed the elegant pedas and buttermilk. Here, every Bandhav was honored by Mr. Hiralal Ji Pandey and his family members by giving them a book on the history of Jalgaon and a symbol, which was greatly appreciated by all the passengers...

After reaching the mansion built at the highest altitude in Holipura village, the caste brothers took the darshan of society veteran Mrs. Kanta Ji Chaturvedi, everyone was overwhelmed by the cordial hospitality shown by her..

All the brothers present enjoyed laddus, peda, petha, various types of snacks and tea. Also obtained various information about Holipura village..

A new tradition has been started by Mr. Mathur Chaturvedi, Chairman of the General Council, under which till now the first meeting of the National Executive was held in Chandigarh, the State Executive meeting was held in Karauli, Kota and each state, the National Executive was held in Bhopal. The National Executive was inaugurated at Atal Dham at 8 pm.

Drawing the attention of the dignitaries present on the stage, he said that like the Bhadawar Yatra, an effective plan should be made for the Brij Darshan Yatra in the future, under which there would be a seven-day yatra of the entire Brij area, for which only the guidance of the General Council is required. Apart from this, the General Council will not have to do anything else. We will be responsible for every work related to the Yatra, and this Yatra should take place during summer or winter vacations, so that more and more of our future generations also participate in this Yatra so that they remain familiar with their values. This proposal is approved by the entire House. Supported with Kartal sound.

In this context, Patron Mr. Brij Mohan Ji Chaturvedi said in his concise address that the zeal and enthusiasm with which all of you brothers and our mother power have participated in this unprecedented and historic journey and made it successful is praiseworthy in a loud voice. Such journeys are definitely necessary, which act

as a bridge for mutual love, brotherly harmony and marital relations.

He said that the same question was prevalent in the minds of many people that what will the General Council be able to do, will its own existence survive or not?

Chowks have been made with flour and turmeric on many auspicious occasions in the Havelis, on Holi and Diwali happiness has been shared by visiting each other's houses, after marriage the daughters in these Havelis perform Dehri Puja and make Swastikas with their hands smeared with turmeric. Has left traces.

Today, remembering all these things, these grand mansions are shedding tears, looking forward to the path of their family Deepaks, who, after spending their childhood here, today live in limited range of houses, flats and duplexes in various big cities. Are making a living..

It is good that you live in the big cities for your prosperity and provide good education to your children, but it is my sincere request that you never forget the heritage of your ancestors and your birthplace. Let us take a new resolution that every person in every village must build a house of his own so that the name of our ancestors remains immortal forever..

In this context, I would like to place a self-request in the form of a proposal before all the respected patrons of Shri Mathur Chaturvedi Maha Parishad, Chairman, General Secretary and the entire executive that the main heritage of Chaturvedi society, Chaturvedi Dharamshala-Bah, which is the heart of Bhadawar region. Marriages, sacred thread ceremonies etc. of many families have been performed in this Dharamshala. During the visit, when I saw the dilapidated condition of this Dharamshala, I was deeply shocked..

First of all, attention will have to be given to giving new life to this property worth crores of Bhadawar area. The General Council should start the construction work of this Dharamshala under its able leadership so that this heritage of our society can be repopulated..

Keeping this sentiment in mind, informed that the construction work of Chaturvedi Dharamshala Bah will start soon, and also announced that the General Council will first provide Rs 11 thousand for this noble work..
